

## **SKIN BIOPSY**

Skin biopsy is a minor procedure in which a small piece of skin tissue is removed and sent to pathology for diagnostic purposes. The biopsy site is numbed with an injection of local anesthetic. The skin specimen is then removed with surgical instrument(s). Bleeding may be controlled with topical agent (Drysol), electrodessication, or suture closure of the wound.

POTENTIAL COMPLICATIONS: pain, fainting, reaction to local anesthesia, bleeding, infection, ulceration, skin discoloration, numbness, and scarring.

## CARE FOR A BIOPSY SITE:

- 1. Leave the bandage on and keep the wound dry for 24 hours.
- 2. After 24 hours, clean wound twice daily with sterile then apply AQUAPHOR, VASELINE, or POLYSPORIN OINTMENT.
- 3. May protect the wound with a band aid or other sterile dressing.
- 4. Return to the clinic for follow-up and/or suture removal in \_\_\_\_ days.
